


Online Trading Partner Agreement Now Available

All newly enrolling trading partners must electronically sign the online Trading Partner Agreement (TPA). **Hardcopy agreements are no longer accepted.** The online TPA is located on the Web Portal > Provider Hotlinks > TPA BAA Authorization.
